Remount has hosted over 500 people since commencing operations in 2016.


Remount Limited is an Australian company limited by guarantee, governed by a Board of Directors.

Remount provides horsemanship programs to veterans and first responders, their families and carers, at no charge. It is fully staffed by volunteers.

Remount is a registered charity and is endorsed as a deductible gift recipient by the Australian Taxation Office. Donations over \$2 are tax deductible.

Remount participants stay on farm at "Gunben" and learn the language of the horse, and then apply these skills to muster cattle as a team.

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer

It is with great pleasure that I once again present the Remount Treasurers report for the financial year 2024. This year's results shows that Remount continues to grow, improving its financial capacity and resilience, to continue to provide much needed programs for the veteran and serving community of our defence forces and first responders.

This year Remounts net profit was \$118,861 down from \$174,232 in 2023. The reason for the lower profit in 2024 was a reduction in revenue of \$27,033, and an increase in expenses and depreciation of \$18,491 and \$9,849 respectively.

The reduction in revenue was a result of a one-off substantial and generous increase in sponsorship in 2023 to fund the acquisition of the Remount truck. The underlying sponsorship in 2023 was \$120,060 compared to \$203,227 in 2024.

This resulted in cash held at the end of 2024 of \$166,234, a reduction of \$46,252 from 30 June 2023. However, whilst there has been a reduction of the Remount cash balance as of 30 June 2024, it is sufficient to fund approximately two years of Remount programs if no additional sponsorship were to be received.

The increase in expenses and depreciation was largely the result of the acquisition of a second-hand truck for \$164,285. The purchase was largely funded by a contribution from a major benefactor. The truck has been a valuable addition to the capacity of Remount to run programs at Gunben and now further afield. This year a team was able to travel to Illabo NSW to participate in a horse-cutting clinic which is a wonderful extension of the Remount experience enabled by the acquisition of the truck. We look forward to more of these off-site opportunities.

Maintaining a strong and resilient financial position is only part of Remount's ability to run our programs. It would not be possible to deliver the Remount programs without the dedicated team of volunteers and the support of the wider community.
